

# proxy\_account

## Synopsis

`proxy_account = user`

This is only to be specified if the administrator wants all jobs to be run under the single *user* account. By default, all jobs are run by the local "qubeproxy" account.



If the administrator would prefer jobs to be run and therefore the files to be owned by the submitting user, see [proxy\\_execution\\_mode](#).

The `proxy_account` is only valid when `proxy_execution_mode=proxy`, and is ignored when `proxy_execution_mode=user`.



### Windows only

If the `proxy_account` is changed, the `proxy_password` must also be changed.

If the administrator chooses to use a ActiveDirectory domain account for `proxy_account`, it is recommended that they also set `worker_host_domain`.

The `proxy_account` value should only the user name, and **not** include the AD name.

## Example

`proxy_account = qubeproxy`

"qubeproxy"
