Properties and Uses

Execution Properties of a Callback:

- 1. Always executed on the Supervisor
- 2. Executed when a 'trigger' is evaluated as true
- 3. Can be executed more than once
- 4. Executed under the Qube user permissions of the user who owns the callback

Common uses of a callback:

- 1. Job dependency chaining
- 2. Job completion email
- 3. Job logging event tracking
- 4. Inter job frame dependency coordination
- 5. Inter job feedback loops
- 6. Job dependency cleanup handling
- 7. Delay the execution of the job until later
