Description

qberr retrieves and prints the standard error log for a single job instance.

Usage

qberr [*options*] *jobID* [.*subjobID*]...

where *subjobID* represents the subjob ID of *jobID*. If the subjob ID is omitted, a subjob ID of 0 is assumed.

Options

Option	Description
--pos <i>int</i>	Starting file position at <i>int</i> bytes
--sleep <i>int</i>	Refresh every <i>int</i> seconds (default: 60)
--follow	Similar to "tail -f"
--help	Command help
--version	Command version
