

# How do I reset the Supervisor MySQL database?



**WARNING:** Performing these operations will discard ALL DATA from the entire PostgreSQL DB!

Basically, you will need to:

1. stop the supervisor service
2. run the `init_supe_db.py` script with the "--reset" option. The script is found in `$QBDIR/Utils/pgsql/`, where `$QBDIR` is:
  - a. Linux: `/usr/local/pfx/qube`
  - b. Mac: `/Applications/pfx/qube`
  - c. Windows: `C:\Program Files\pfx\qube`
3. start the supervisor service

Again, **this wipes all existing data**, so make sure that's what you really want.

## Linux:

Open a terminal window as root, then:

```
service supervisor stop
/usr/local/pfx/qube/Utils/pgsql/init_supe_db.py --reset
service supervisor start
```

## Mac:

Open a terminal window, then:

```
sudo launchctl stop com.pipelinefx.supervisor
/Applications/pfx/qube/Utils/pgsql/init_supe_db.py --reset
sudo launchctl start com.pipelinefx.supervisor
```

## Windows:

Open a command prompt, then:

```
net stop qubesupervisor
"C:\Program Files\pfx\qube\Utils\pgsql\init_supe_db.py" --reset
net start qubesupervisor
```
